

OMAK STAMPEDE, INC.
GRAND PARADE RULES

1. NO THROWING OF CANDY FROM A MOVING VEHICLE. Any candy must be given out by **out walkers only**. Candy must be tossed into the crowd or onto the sidewalk. We do not want any candy lying in the street in the path of the next entry. All out walkers must be 12 years of age or older and must measure at least 48 inches in height. Store bought candy only. All candy must be wrapped.
2. NO POLITICAL LITERATURE PASSED OUT – **This will be strictly enforced.**
3. FLOATS: Components (including truck or tractor) should be 80% decorated. Floats must meet fire and ventilation safety standards and must be mechanically dependable. Driver must remain with the float. **YOUR FLOAT INSPECTION SHEET NEEDS TO BE FILLED OUT, SIGNED AND ACCOMPANY YOUR FLOAT TO THE STAGING INSPECTION.** If it fails the inspection or the inspection sheet is not in proper order, you will not be allowed to participate.
4. LINE UP TIMES:

7:00a.m.	Check in opens
<u>9:00a.m. sharp</u>	Judging
9:45a.m.	Awards given out
10:00a.m.	Parade Starts

All awards will be given out at the start of the Parade. Anyone NOT wishing to be judged may sign in between the hour of 8:30a.m. and 9:30a.m. Anyone signing in after 8:30a.m. will not be judged. Please be ready at 9:45a.m. for the Parade.

5. You will receive your line up position from our check-in stand at the staging area. Numbered cones will be placed on the street. A parade person will help you find your cones and direct you to the right street.
6. At the end of the parade, FOLLOW THE PARADE MARSHALS DIRECTION TO DISPERSAL AREA. NO EXCEPTIONS – EVERYONE MUST FOLLOW THE ROUTE.
7. Motorcycles, three and four wheelers, ATV's – **WHEELIES NOT ALLOWED.** Helmets are optional in the Parade – before or after, you may get a ticket.
8. American and Canadian flags may be carried RESPECTFULLY. If the Parade Director determines that there is ANY disrespect being shown to the flag, you will be asked to leave immediately.
9. OMAK STAMPEDE, INC., AND DESIGNATED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY UNIT NOT CONFORMING TO THE ABOVE RULES, OR OTHER LAWS PERTAINING TO THE SAFETY OF OTHERS.
10. There will be an area for Floats that are coming in early. All floats must have a float inspection list from the Safety Officer.
